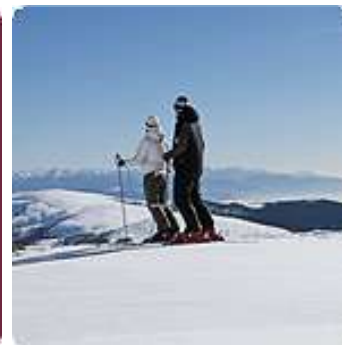

Discover the ski resorts of the holiday region Merano and environs with the new SkiCard by taking advantage of this attractive offer. Five ski resorts with completely different features, ranging from the pure nature paradise at 1,500 m altitude to a challenging glacier ski resort at 3,200 m a.s.l., await your visit to enjoy the winter world.

You have the choice between a 2-, 3-, 4-, 5-, or 6-day card, valid for use within 7 days. The card allows you to visit each of the individual ski resorts twice. All of the participating ski resorts are situated near to the urban centre of Merano and are comfortably reachable by car or public transport within 30 – 60 minutes.

The SkiCard offers you free entrance to 33 cableways and funicular systems, over 115 km of slopes, 65 km of cross-country skiing slopes, 11 toboggan runs and 4 ski kindergartens.

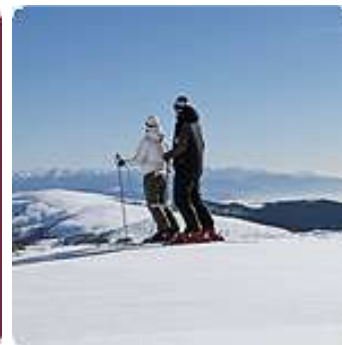

Merano 2000 (1.670 – 2.300 m a.s.l.)

Above the enchanting city of Merano with its captive 'Belle-Époque' flair lies the sunny ski resort Merano 2000. The area is an ideal destination for families and beginner-level skiers and can be easily accessed with the newly-installed cable car. Guests can expect Italian gastronomic specialties and the traditional high-quality local cuisine while marveling an impressive panorama view over the Alps.

Season: 2011/12/03 – 2012/04/09

- » Opening hours: from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- » Cableways: 1 cable car, 1 gondola ropeway, 5 chair lifts
- » Ski slopes: 40 km
- » Cross-country skiing – trails: Falzeben (3 km)
- » Toboggan run: Merano 2000 (2,8 km), alpine pasture 'Malga Leadner/Leadner Alm' – Verano/Vöran (600 m)

Val Senales/Schnals Valley (2.011 – 3.212 m a.s.l.)

On the glacier of Val Senales, the champions of international competitive skiing gather for training. The ski resort offers 35 km of slopes and excellent snow conditions for the genuine enjoyment of the active downhill skier, snowboarder or cross-country enthusiast.

- » Season: 2011/06/11 – 2012/04/15
- » Opening hours: from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.
- » Cableways: 1 cablecar, 7 chair lifts, 4 ski lifts
- » Ski slopes: 35 km
- » Cross-country skiing – trails: glacier cross-country ski run Hochjoch 2 (5 km), winter cross-country ski run Lazaun (2 km)
- » Toboggan run: Lazaun (3,3 km)
- » Funpark

Schwemmalm (1.150 – 2.600 m a.s.l.)

The broad slopes are within the medium level of difficulty; the magnificent views of the surrounding mountains and an atmosphere of an untouched and remote alpine valley distinguish the ski resort Schwemmalm. The facilities are completed by a cross-country trail set in the valley and trails for snowshoe hikers and back country skiers.

- » Season: 2011/12/08 – 2012/04/14
- » Opening hours: from 8.30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- » Cableways: 1 gondola ropeway, 4 chair lifts, 1 ski lift
- » Ski slopes: 25 km
- » Cross-country skiing – trails: cross-country ski run Ulten Valley (12 – 25 km)
- » Toboggan run 'Moscha' (450 m)

Plan/Pfelders (1.601 - 2.502 m a.s.l.)

At the ski resort Plan guests walk only three minutes from their accommodation to the ski lift. The car can be left in front of the hotel for the entire holiday, and day visitors can park just outside the village. The open mobility in Plan is mainly provided by skis, cross-country skis or toboggans, but there is also a local shuttle train line, ideal for those who like to take it easy. This romantic village, set at the end of the remote Val Passiria/Passeier Valley, is an idyllic place for families and nature enthusiasts, and guarantees a large amount of natural snow.

- » Season: 2011/12/03 – 2012/04/15
- » Opening hours: from 9 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.
- » Cableways: 1 combined installation, 1 chair lift with seat heating, 2 ski lifts
- » Ski slopes: 10 km
- » Cross-country skiing – trails: cross-country ski run in Innerhütt (5 km), cross-country ski run to the Lazins Valley (12 km)
- » Toboggan run: Plan – alpine pasture ‘Grünboden’ (3,5 km), Plan – family toboggan run (450 m), Plan – Gampen (700 m), Plata/Platt (700 m), Corvara/Rabenstein (800 m), Sulles/Stuls (2 km)

Monte San Vigilio/Vigiljoch (1.486 – 1.814 m a.s.l.)

Monte San Vigilio, located above the village of Lana, is a perfect area for all those who enjoy the purity of nature. It boasts the second oldest cableway in the entire country, but modern technology is still present in the background. Monte San Vigilio is a small and romantic ski resort, and its mild snow-laden hills and open vantage point on the Dolomites make it perfectly suited for both nature lovers and moderate sport enthusiasts. Here, one can find winter in its most original form by hiking, taking a toboggan run or making a trip on snowshoes.

- » Season: 2011/12/16 – 2012/03/11
- » Opening hours: Weekend and holidays from 9.00 a.m. to 5 p.m., on weekdays from 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 1.30 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.
- » Cableways: 1 cablecar, 1 chair lift, 2 ski lifts
- » Ski slopes: 5 km
- » Cross-country skiing-trails: 4 km cross-country ski run at the Monte San Vigilio
- » Toboggan run: toboggan run Monte San Vigilio (2 km)
